SUBJECT:	Supplemental Budget Resolution 2024-URA-04

BACKGROUND

On June 12th, 2023, the Hood River Urban Renewal Agency adopted the Appropriations Resolution 2023-URA-02 governing the Agency's Adopted Budget for Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-24. Routinely midyear changes in revenue or operating conditions require adjustments to appropriations. ORS 294.471 allows the governing body of a municipal corporation to adopt a Supplemental Budget by ordinance or resolution.

DISCUSSION

The attached Supplemental Budget, Resolution 2024-URA-04, makes the following adjustments:

URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY GENERAL FUND

Trainings & Meetings

\$4.000

Budgeted contingency is used to add funds for real estate development training at Portland State University. These educational expenses were negotiated at the hire of Urban Renewal Administrator. The coursework is related to the housing and development goals of the new Westside Urban Renewal District and the creation of its 5-Year Action Plan.

COLUMBIA-CASCADE DISTRICT

Remit Excess Interest Earnings to Hood River Tax Collector

\$179.827

Accumulated interest earnings on tax increment revenues held in fund balance currently exceed the Columbia-Cascade District's remaining Maximum Indebtedness. Under ORS 457.450, these earnings are remitted to the Hood River County Tax Collector for distribution to overlapping taxing jurisdictions. The Urban Renewal Agency will continue to remit interest earnings on an annual basis until the Columbia-Cascade District is shuttered. This expense will be included in future Columbia-Cascade District budgets. This Supplemental Budget recognizes a higher than budgeted FY2023-24 Beginning Fund Balance to make this payment. Beginning fund balance not needed for the remittance is allocated to Contingency.

These annual accumulated interest earning remittances do not reduce the originally authorized Maximum Indebtedness spending levels for Columbia-Cascade projects. The remittances ensure that the District does not over spend its originally authorized spending authority by collecting interest on accrued tax increment balances.

HEIGHTS DISTRICT

\$50.000

Real-estate Purchase Resolution 2024-URA-02 authorized the purchase of 1217 May Street. This property is needed for an eventual roundabout located at May and 13th street envisioned by the Heights Streetscape Plan. The

Heights Streetscape Plan was formally incorporated into the Heights District Plan by <u>Resolution 2024-URA-01</u>. This Supplemental Budget transfers \$50,000 in budgeted contingency to pay earnest money on the property to begin the due diligence period. The balance of the purchase price is required at closing, which will occur in FY2024-25.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The adjusted amounts are described in the report above and in the attached resolution.

RECOMMENDATION(S)

Support Resolution No. 2024-URA-04, a Supplemental Budget, to make appropriations and adjust the adopted budget for Fiscal Year 2023-24.

RECOMMENDATION(S)

The Urban Renewal Advisory Committee reviewed Resolution No. 2024-URA-04 at their April 18th Regular Meeting. The Advisory Committee unanimously supported the Supplemental Budget.
